A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING AN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT FOR INTERIM CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the City of Hermosa Beach is a General Law City under California law and is governed by and elected City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager reports to and is appointed by the City Council of the City of Hermosa Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved the request to hire an Interim City Manager under an “at-will” employment agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” until such time as a permanent City Manager can be appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Employment Agreement for Interim City Manager (attached as Exhibit “A”) is hereby approved and the Mayor is directed to execute.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager is authorized and directed to commence performance of the duties of the position upon the effective date of the agreement.

SECTION 3. Environmental Review. Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061 (b) (3), it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity contemplated by this resolution may have a significant effect on the environment.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision will not affect the validity of the remainder of this resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this resolution, and each and every section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof is declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. Record of Proceedings. This resolution takes effect immediately and that the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution; shall cause the same to be entered among the original resolutions of said City; and shall make a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City

Council of said City in the minutes of the meeting at which time same is passed and adopted. The City Clerk shall keep a copy of same along with such other documents and records of proceedings as may be designated by the City Manager.
