

FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO PROVIDE ON-CALL ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH AND WESTGROUP DESIGNS

This Fourth Amendment to the Agreement for Professional Services to Provide On-Call Architectural Services is entered into by and between the City of Hermosa Beach, a municipal corporation ("City") and Westgroup Designs ("CONSULTANT") as of October 11, 2025.

RECITALS

- A. City and Consultant are parties to an Agreement dated October 10, 2019 (the "Agreement") by which City engaged Consultant to provide architectural consulting services to the City.
- B. The Consultant continues to perform authorized work for the City, in accordance with Section 4 of the original Agreement, and the City desires to maintain the Consultant's services to retain internal knowledge and consistency on ongoing projects until all authorized work is completed.
- C. The First Amendment to the Agreement, executed on October 11, 2022, extended the term to October 10, 2023.
- D. The Second Amendment to the Agreement, executed on October 11, 2023, extended the term to October 11, 2024.
- E. The Third Amendment to the Agreement, executed on October 11, 2024, extended the term to October 11, 2025.
- F. City and Consultant now desire to amend the Agreement in order to extend the term of the Agreement to expire on October 11, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Agreement is amended as follows:

- 1. Section 7 of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

TERM OF AGREEMENT. The term of this Agreement shall commence upon execution by both parties and shall expire on October 11, 2026, unless earlier termination occurs in accordance with the Agreement, or this Agreement is extended in writing by both parties.

Except as above modified, in all other respects the Agreement is hereby reaffirmed in full force and effect.
